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Lord of the Flies

- **What happened to the aircraft carrying the boys?**

Ans:

Ans:

They are small, dirty, tanned, and often have bad dreams.

- **What evil thing does Roger do to Henry?**

Ans:

Roger throws stones at Henry but misses him.

- **How do the boys miss a chance of rescue?**

Ans:

The signal fire goes out, and a passing ship does not see them.

- **Why does Jack slap Piggy?**

Ans:

Jack slaps Piggy for blaming him for letting the fire go out.

- **Why does Jack apologize to Ralph?**

Ans:

He says sorry for letting the fire out but not for hurting Piggy.

- **What does the pig dance symbolize?**

Ans:

It shows their loss of order and return to savagery.

- **What is Simon's attitude to the beast?**

Ans:

Simon says the beast is inside their own hearts.

- **What makes Jack disregard Ralph as the leader?**

Ans:

Jack mocks Piggy and ignores the conch and Ralph's authority.

- **When does the second mock hunt occur?**

Ans

: It happens when the boys search for the beast.

- **What happens to Robert during the second mock hunt?**

Ans:

The boys hit Robert hard while pretending he is a pig.

- **What is Ralph's role during the second mock hunt?**

Ans:

Ralph joins the game and also hits Robert.

- **What is a conch?**

Ans:

- **How is Piggy killed?**
