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Themes

- Love between Father and Son:** The poem shows the poet's deep love for his father. He wants his father to stay strong and not give up easily.
- Human Courage:** The poet admires people who face death with courage. He shows that strength of spirit can shine even in the darkest time.
- Light and Darkness:** Light means life and hope; darkness means death. The poet uses these symbols to show the fight between life and death.
- Universality of Death:** Death comes to everyone — wise, good, wild, or grave men. The poet says no one can escape death, but we can face it with power and dignity.
