Important Quotes

"It was my thirtieth year to heaven"

Explanation:

Thomas writes this poem as a celebration of his thirtieth birthday. He also sees his life as a spiritual journey toward heaven. This is a religious element in this poem.

"...the heron

Priested shore"

Exp: The poet imagines the heron as a priest blessing the land. This is another religious element. ***"The morning beckon***

With water praying and call of seagull and rook"

Exp: Thomas is describing the early morning nature near the sea shore. He hears the call of seagulls and rook. The sound of water seems like a praying sound to him, calm and continuous. So, nature is alive here, full of sound.

"And I rose

In rainy autumn

And walked abroad in a shower of all my days."

Exp: It is a rainy Autumn morning. The poet imagines the rain is showering down all his past days on him. It means the rain is bringing back his memories.

*"And I saw in the turning so clearly a child's
Forgotten mornings when he walked with his mother"*

Exp:

The poet feels that Autumn has suddenly changed to summer. He goes back to his childhood summer when he walked with his mother. Hence, the beautiful nature on the hill brings back his childhood memories.

*"O may my heart's truth
Still be sung
On this high hill in a year's turning."*

Exp:

Thomas ends the poem with a prayer. He wishes to return to the same high hill every year and feel the same joy he felt as a child.
